Students AT ALL classes should wear the following attire:

BALLET

Mulberry sleeveless ballet leotard

Ballet socks or tights

Character shoes

Character skirt (rent out)

Cardigan (optional for winter)



Grade 3/4

Teal sleeveless ballet leotard

Ballet socks or tights

Soft ballet shoes

Character shoes

Character skirt (rent out)

Cardigan (optional for winter)

Lavender sleeveless ballet leotard
Ballet socks or tights
Soft ballet shoes
Character skirt (rent out)

Intermediate Foundation, Intermediate

Purple ballet leotard
Ballet socks or tights
Split sole ballet shoes/Pointe shoes
Cardigan (optional for winter)
Classical tutu skirt for variation 1 (optional)
Short skirt without pattern to match leotard (recommended)



Advanced Foundation- Advanced II

Royal blue ballet leotard
Ballet socks or tights
Split sole ballet shoes/ Pointe shoes
Ballet wrap cardigan (optional for winter)
Classical tutu skirt for variation 1 (optional)
Short skirt without pattern to match leotard (recommended)



Switch-it-up Leotard

For Intermediate Foundation grades and up. Think of this as your “backup dancer” leotard—for those days your favorite one is still in the washing machine, or when class just needs a costume change.

OUTPLAY DANCE DRESS CODE

CONTEMPORARY/JAZZ/SPOTLIGHT

Outplay T shirt or Ballet leotard
Full-length black leggings or Jazz pants
Dance black shorts over leggings (optional)
Dance black socks that provide some grip
Black Kneecaps
Jazz sneakers (optional for Jazz)

Hair for Contemporary & Jazz: should be pulled back and secured away from the face to ensure unobstructed movement. Styles like ponytails, buns, or braids work well.

ACRO HOP BEATS I & II

Outplay T-Shirt
Black shorts, slim-fit sweatpants/joggers
Black socks

HIP HOP/STREET DANCE/DANCEHALL/BREAKDANCE

Outplay T shirt
Loose-fitting pants such as cargo pants, joggers or sweatpants
Clean, supportive sneakers designed for dance or athletic use. Jazz sneakers are recommended.
No street shoes or shoes worn outside of the studio should be permitted to maintain cleanliness and safety in the dance space.
